The Anglo-German Officers' Association

Formed in 1990, this tri-Service association is open to all British and German officers, serving or retired, who have served in any capacity with the other nation's Forces; as students, instructors, liaison or exchange officers, as attachés in Bonn or London, or with the Joint Services Liaison Organisation. The aim of the association is to foster and enhance close relations between the Bundeswehr and British Forces.

A meeting is held in alternate years in Germany and the UK, the most recent taking place at the RAF Staff College, Bracknell on 29-30 January 1993. Guest speakers included Sir Oliver Wright, former Ambassador in Bonn, Baron Hermann von Richthofen, German Ambassador in London, and the Generalinspekteur der Bundeswehr, General Klaus Naumann. Marshal of the Royal Air Force Sir Peter Harding gave an after dinner address at the Ladies' Guest Night at which a section of the Central Band of the RAF played. The Meeting included presentations by the Director of Military Operations on operations in Bosnia and by 47 Squadron RAF on the air support of UN operations.
